

Case study: Kāpiti Coast District Council Community Engagement Te Ara Whetū (Waikanae Library)

GOAL: Find out what was important to people and which options the community preferred.





BRIEF:

- Create visuals to tie the look of physical and digital consultation together.
- Work across a range of items: from posters, brochures to social media.
- · Accommodate bi-lingual content.
- Show aspects of a modern library like community engagement, learning, performance, events and digital resources.

APPROACH:

I used a collage technique on blocks of bold colours which allowed for:


- A family 'look and feel' while allowing for flexibility across shapes, sizes and channels.
- A mix and match suite of retro illustrations, photos, shapes and silhouettes that suggest aspects of a modern library without being too specific.

RESULT:

- The council agreed to the option selected by 50% of the respondents, and will refurbish the former library.
- More than 500 individuals visited the engagement centre or interacted at community markets and other venues.
- Over 3000 comments via post-it notes and online survey/ idea boards.
